# eccna chair report 5-13-2013 host chair mike r

hello. 32 days til eccna 17. thank you all for your service so far.

The AB met last on 5/6/2013. As of 5/4/13 there was \$29,351 in AB account, 100 in AB savings, 3446 in Paypal, and 1426 in Host acc less outstanding checks. total ECCNA cash = \$34,323. Current to today, there were 97 full pay apts, 4 full pay dorm, 10 deposits paid, 9 full pay Thursday night apts, 2 Sunday nights, and 54 day registrations, also we have sold additional 7 Fri Dinner, 7 Sat Breakfast, 6 Sat Lunch, 9 Sat Dinner, and 7 Sunday Breakfasts. They are interested in the prison and jail list and I gave them the rundown and Kim and I are still working on it. The AB m2p to accept Charles Jr for Sunday morning substitute speaker. We set the prices for the merchandise at the convention. Old business was internal guidelines, 2 year bid cycle discussion, liability insurance, short discussion on bracelets and tickets for meals. New business was on the June 1 number for WC, Internal guidelines, merch prices, and merch times.
